



Pirie West / Napperby Combined Sports Day

Dear parents / caregivers,

This year we have an exciting opportunity to participate in the combined Pirie West / Napperby Sports Day.

This will be a great opportunity for our students to interact and compete against a new group of students. Building relationships with other students in the Pirie schools partnership is extremely important, particularly for those students who are about to transition to John Pirie Secondary School.

Students will be in the same house colours as they were for the Napperby Sports Day. **Blue** – Flinders/Hughes, **Red** – Pirie/Price and **Yellow** – Eyre/Fisher. Students are allowed to wear hair spray and face paint on the day.

The setup of the day is very similar to how our Sports Day was organised this year. Students in R to Year 2 will participate in the Junior Primary Tabloid events. Mrs Jacob's class will remain as one group and the Year 1 and 2 students from Mrs Nicholl's class will join in with Miss Catherine Harding's Year 2 group with the support of Gabby Dennis. The Year 3 to Year 7 students will participate in the Upper Primary team games.

All students are required to be at Napperby Primary School by 9:00am. Students will be travelling to and from the event on a bus provided by the school. If you are attending the day and you would like to collect your child after the event, please advise their classroom teacher. Students that are not collected will return to Napperby Primary School on the bus by 2:30pm. Students can be collected from school at this time or remain at school until normal finishing time.

There will be full canteen facilities available on the day. Students can choose to access the canteen or are more than welcome to bring a packed lunch. Students will keep their bags with them throughout the day.
